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## 4 FIRST AID MEASURES

## 5 FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

**Extinguishing Media:** Use water spray to cool containers. Use fire-extinguishing media appropriate for surrounding materials.  
**Exposure Hazards:** Product is non-flammable. In combustion containers may emit toxic fumes.  
**Protection:** Wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

## 6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

**Personal Precautions:** Contain spillage if possible without risk. Do not take action without suitable protective clothing (*see section 8*).  
**Environmental Precautions:** Do not discharge into water sources or sewers. Contain spillage using bunding.  
**Clean-up Procedures:** Absorb in vermiculite, dry sand or earth. Transfer to a closeable, labelled, salvage container for disposal.

## 7 HANDLING AND STORAGE

**Handling Requirements:** Eye protection should be considered where there is a risk of splashing.  
Suitable protective gloves and barrier cream are recommended when using any chemical.  
**Storage:** Store in cool, well ventilated area. Keep in original container only. Keep container tightly closed.

## 8 EXPOSURE CONTROLS / PERSONAL PROTECTION

**Hand Protection:** For prolonged or repeated skin contact use suitable protective gloves.  
**Eye Protection:** Safety glasses are not normally required. However their use is recommended where there is a risk of spray mist or splashing when using or handling product.
